FINANCIAL AID FOR SUPERVISED MINISTRY AND CPE

Yale Divinity School provides up to \$4,000 toward the first year or first summer of Supervised Ministry Internships. Sites are *invited* but not required to contribute to the stipend. This allows students to select a site independent of the site's ability to pay them, thus expanding opportunities for internships in economically disadvantaged settings.

Part-time Academic Year Internship

\$2,000 (or one-half the total YDS stipend) is applied to the student's Yale account at the first of fall and spring semesters.

Summer Intensive Internships

Like the Part-Time Internship with Practicum (REL 3886-7) the Supervised Ministry Intensive is a YDS course (REL 3986-9). Hence students must pay summer tuition (check with the Registrar, but roughly \$2,400 for 6 hours). If you receive financial aid, a portion of your financial aid formula will be applied. See the Office of Financial Aid for details. The \$4,000 stipend is paid monthly as a graduate student stipend starting the first of June.

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE)

If Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is taken for 6 YDS transfer credits, YDS will pay \$4,000 to the student as work-study income. A form must be signed by the CPE supervisor and submitted weekly, employment taxes will be deducted, and payroll checks will be received weekly in an amount that will total \$4,000 (gross) over the entire CPE unit. The student's net income will be slightly less than \$4,000 due to payroll taxes.

CPE is independent of Yale, so students do not pay YDS tuition for CPE. However, most CPE sites charge tuition for their program. Some of the programs offer financial aid; a few offer stipends. If a site offers a stipend, the student will receive YDS funding only to the extent needed to insure a minimum stipend of \$4,000 for the CPE unit.

The funding for CPE is not counted toward the \$4,000 guaranteed for the first internship. That is, you can receive \$4,000 for your summer CPE *and* \$4,000 for one academic year internship. Additional internships can be taken for elective credit (up to 15 hours), and every effort will be made to provide financial support for internships beyond the first one.
